PSAT

(Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) What: The PSAT is offered once a year in mid-October. Students are required to register for the exam on or before September18th by 3:30. Testing Fee is \$16.00 and is due when you register. The PSAT is 2 hours and 45 minutes long, tests your skills in Reading, Writing, and Math and is administered on October 11th.

<u>Who</u>: Sophomores can take the PSAT but will not qualify for scholarships. To qualify for scholarships the PSAT must be taken during your **junior** year.
